





Himalayan University's Bachelor of Science in Zoology degree is part of the NEP-2020 initiative. Students will be given a UG certificate, UG diploma, UG degree, and UG degree (Honours with Research) in Zoology after successfully completing one, two, three, and four years, respectively. It is intended that after completing this four-year degree, students will be trained in transdisciplinary elements of natural resource exploration and sustainable use and will be equipped with self-reliant and biological entrepreneur skills.

- 3. The External Members gave their expertise on the draft syllabus to be finalized. 4. It was decided that the Paper "Plant Physiology and Biochemistry" be categorized under Major Course and the Paper "Plant Biotechnology" be categorized under Minor
- 5. The External Members suggested that the Suggested Reading Section should be at least 5-10 in numbers and include foreign authors as well.

6. The members agreed to provide Practical classes as per facilities/infrastructures available in the University.

- 7. It was decided that final edited syllabus be re-sent to External Members for the final verification.
- 8. The members agreed to make any further corrections in next meeting, if required.
